

Product Choices/Changes – April 2019

Many of our familiar products have undergone design changes. We updated the Treadwall (new "FT" series) and added a larger option for the Boulderboard. The following is a quick guide.

Treadwall®FT Line

We now offer a **full line that has three options** (frame, width and height) that you combine to meet any space or budget.

- Base and Pro Packages will be offered.
- Frame color will change to dark grey.
- Panel materials will be natural wood.

1. Frames:

Max Frames – <u>Maximum</u> frame, with full +10 degrees (slab) **to -35 degrees** (overhanging) angles: range required for climbing-focused training and more intense training.

S Frames - <u>S</u>tandard frame with +10 degrees (slab) **to -15 degrees** (overhanging) angles: same angle range as the previous M6 Pro, minimal footprint with great training angles.

V Frames - <u>Vertical only</u> frame, **no angle adjustment**, located against a wall for absolute minimal footprint.

Kore Frames – These are <u>residential only</u> units, using the same frames as in the previous Kore series. Any non-residential use will void the warranty.

2. Width:

Six Feet wide – Full width climbing, same as the M6 series previously made **Four feet wide** – smaller footprint, same as the M4 series previously made

3. Height:

10-foot wall – The lowest option for ceiling height issues.

11-foot wall – The standard height, same as the previous M6 and M4 Pro models.

12-foot wall – The largest wall option, helpful for climbing focus. (n/a on V and Kore frames) This is the same size as on the previous Kore Pro.

Models will have the following types of names:

The S frame, 4 feet wide with an 11-foot wall = \$4/11

The Max frame, 6 feet wide with a 12-foot wall = Max6/12

A V frame, 4-feet wide and a 10-foot wall = V4/10

A home Kore unit, 6-feet wide, 11-foot wall = **Kore6/11**

Orders specifying existing models will be filled with the equivalent new, upgraded model.

Laddermill® Ascender Line

The Laddermill will remain the same.

- No Base or Pro options: there is one product, model LM-1.
- Frame color will change to dark grey.

Boulderboard® Training Stations

The Boulderboard **will now have two versions**: a 4-foot version we currently make and a new 6-foot version. The top pull-up bar is re-designed to a sleeker version. On the base version, the tee nuts will be inserted by the customers.

- Base and Pro Packages will be used.
- · Frame color will change to dark grey.
- Panel materials will be natural wood.

Frames:

4-foot Wide Frame – Climbing surface is 4-feet wide by 10-feet long – no change. **6-foot Wide Frame** – Climbing surface is 6-feet wide by 10-feet long - New 2019.

Ledgewall™ Climbing panels

The panels **remain the same** with one key change: a much higher quality tee nut is now used that is far better than anything before. This means minimal cross threading and easier use when locating holds.
